Any entry form received without payment in full or not completed will be returned without exception. Fresh cattle work in the Expo on Sunday 9/14 at 8 a.m. 3 fresh head per entry with 4 minutes to work.

Fresh cattle works in Expo limited to first 100 entries.

As a condition of my entry, my entering releases the ACHA; show management, and the Bell County Expo Center of any liability for accidents, bodily injury or damage to any animal, equipment or other personal property. This waiver is binding on all riders; grooms and helpers associated with the participation of the horse(s) described herein this event. This Association has the right to refuse any entries.

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR THE 2008 ACHA CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

1. Only horses and riders who have qualified under current ACHA rules may enter Championship Show, rider and owner are responsible for making sure they are qualified for classes entered.
Horses and riders entered in the limited age events held in conjunction with the Championship Show do not have to qualify for classes entered with the exception of the Qualifiers Incentive Class.
2. Entries must be received in the ACHA office by 9/2/08 at 5:00 p.m. Late entries will be received until 9/9/08 at 5:00 p.m. with a \$100 per entry late fee in the ACHA Office. Any entries received without payment in full will be returned. Payments may be made by paying with personal check, money order, cashier's check or cash.
3. Horse substitutions will be allowed in all Non-Pro classes the day prior to show day; as long as the rider has met all qualification requirements for that class. Please see shootout rules below.
4. ACHA has the right to refuse any entry without notice, or cancel an event without notice, entry fees will be returned.
5. The draw for working order will be on posted on Sunday, Sept 14 at Bell County Expo.
6. No refunds will be made for any reason after the draw.
7. There will be three fresh cows for each entry in the go round and in the Finals.
8. The finals shall consist of the top 30% of the entries in the go round with a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 15 plus ties in aged events and regular classes. **Any class with 15 entries or less will only have 1 go.** It is the contestant's responsibility to know when they are to show.
9. Scores in the finals only will determine the final placing. Ties will be broken by go round scores, and if still tied, will result in a tie. Awards will also be decided by go round scores. Prize money in all ties in the finals will be divided evenly.
10. There will not be an advancement fee for the finalist in the regular classes, aged event classes will have an advancement fee of \$125.00 (advancement fees will be withheld from payout).
11. All prize money will be paid in the finals and all finalists will receive a check in Championship classes in both the regular and aged event shows. The checks will be issued at the Show.
12. A three (3) judge system will be used and the 3 scores added together for a final score.
13. All other rules of the ACHA shall be strictly enforced.
14. ACHA reserves the right to cancel any class for lack of entries.
15. Entries must include a copy of horse's registration papers and a copy of coggins good through the show.
16. All persons receiving a check must complete a W-9.
17. A check made payable to the ACHA must be on hand at cattle works pen in order to work or pay in full after each work, cattle works are \$40 and flag works are \$20.
18. McDonalds/Holsey Foundation Shootout will be the top 5 Senior and the top 5 Junior Youth in the Youth Class Point year. There will be a trophy saddle given to the First Place winner in each category, one go. You must show the horse that you have earned the most points on during the point year in the youth class. You will be notified of your position in the shootout prior to the show, in the case that a qualifier is unable to show the next person in line will be moved up into the show. Fresh cattle.
